The tenth day of the seventh month (named Tishri) in the Hebrew calendar is the Day of Atonement. It was a time when an annual ritual was performed to take away the sins of the people (Leviticus 23, Hebrews 9:22). Today, during this twenty-four hour period, true Christians do not eat anything at all and come together to worship of Lord.

Answer: The Day of Atonement (Leviticus 23:27-28), also known as Yom Kippur, was the most solemn holy day of all the Israelite feasts and festivals, occurring once a year on the tenth day of Tishri, the seventh month of the Hebrew calendar. On that day, the high priest was to perform elaborate rituals to atone for the sins of the people.

Erev Yom Kippur (lit. "eve [of] day [of] atonement") is the day preceding Yom Kippur, corresponding to the ninth day of the Hebrew month of Tishrei. This day is commemorated with additional morning prayers , asking others for forgiveness, giving charity , performing the kapparot ritual, an extended afternoon prayer service , and two festive meals.

The "Day of Atonement" is the English phrase for Yom Kippur. The shoresh [root] for the word "Kippur" is kafar (??????), which probably derives from the word kofer, meaning "ransom." This word is parallel to the word "redeem" (Psalm 49:7) and means "to atone by offering a substitute."

The animal on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat was to stand alive before the Lord, to make atonement with him (verse 10; see Hebrews 8:3; 1 Peter 3:18). The Day of Atonement was designed to deal with all these realities. Most of the procedures followed on the Day of Atonement were similar to those followed for the other offerings except that the blood of the sacrifices was sprinkled on the mercy seat in the Most Holy Place as well (Lev. 16:14).
